The inaugural Gas Safety Management Conference will take place at the Belfry on 24 April 2013 and will

- create one voice for gas safety in the Social Housing and Facilities Management industry
- build leadership and recognition for Managers responsible for gas safety in Social Housing and Facilities Management

Delegates

Delegates to the Conference will be Managers in Housing Associations and Facilities Management responsible for gas safety within their organisations. The delegates will include members of the newly formed Association of Gas Safety Managers (AGSM) and the Conference will host the first National Inter-Authority Gas Forum.

Conference structure, theme and topics:-

The Conference will be a one day event on Wednesday 24 April 2013 with pre-Conference dinner on 23rd April.

The pre-Conference dinner will include a drinks reception, a speaker and an Awards session to recognise newly-qualified professional Gas Managers.

The Conference will have a central stream of keynote speakers and debates in the morning sessions and smaller seminars and break-out sessions in the afternoon. The day will conclude with a further keynote speaker.

Speakers and topics will include:

- a Minister or MP speaking on legislative drivers to change
- a CEO from a Housing Association speaking on the impact of cuts on safety and compliance
- a personal view on the impact of CO poisoning and how Housing Associations should be addressing this issue
- a lawyer on the reality of the corporate manslaughter legislation
- a session on how to influence CEOs and senior management
- a debate on the issues relating to using in-house staff or contractors
- a session on the impact of renewables and new build projects on gas safety

There will also be an Exhibition of suppliers to the industry.
