Who is the qualification for?

The qualification is for anyone in Social Housing who is responsible for gas safety management in their organisation including Gas Managers, Asset Managers, Contract Managers or similar.

The CORGI Level 4 VRQ Certificate in Gas Safety Management in Social Housing is a one day guided learning event taken by experienced CORGI tutors, followed by self-study modules and assessment-based distance learning which is supported by the CORGI tutors.

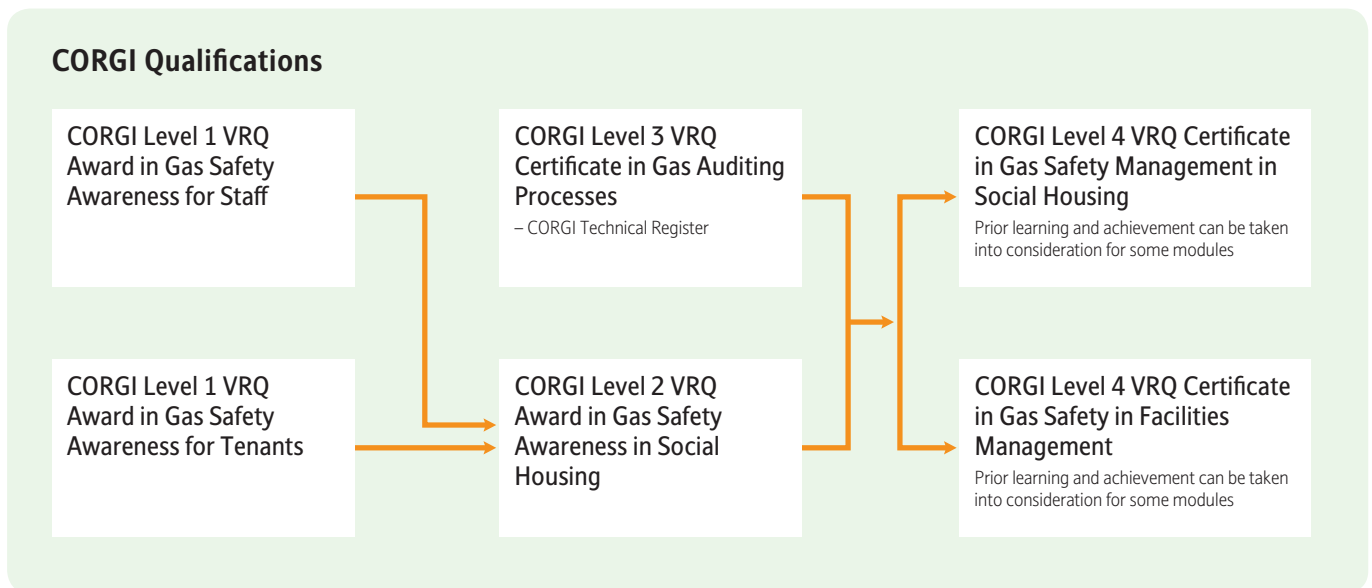
The qualification consists of five units:-

- **Gas Safety Legislation**
An understanding of industry documentation and standards, and how they affect the work undertaken by qualified operatives
- **Gas in Social Housing**
The requirements of social housing providers when dealing with gas in all aspects of their work, covering such areas as employee awareness and quality control
- **Carbon Monoxide**
An explanation of the combustion process, how carbon monoxide is formed, its effect on the human body and how to spot the danger signs
- **Flues and Ventilation**
An in-depth look at two of the most important aspects that determine the safe functioning of appliances
- **Appliances, Meters and Pipework**
An understanding of the different types of appliances, meter and gas installations that are found in social housing properties



The qualification, training and assessment have been developed by CORGI Technical Services and accredited by EAL.
